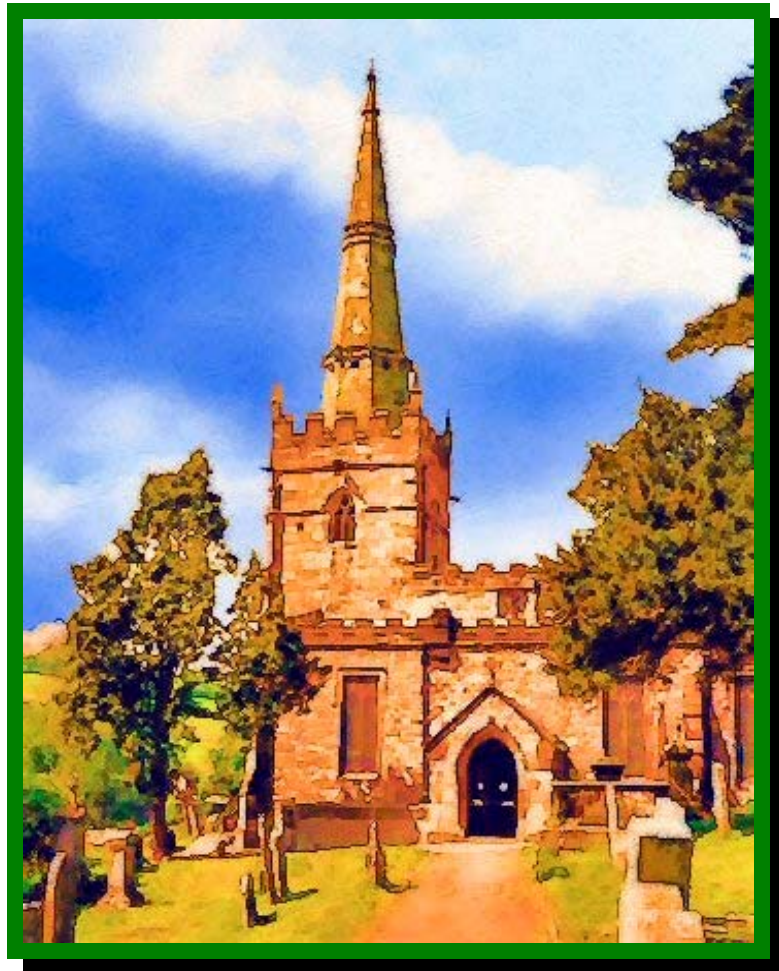

GENERAL INFORMATION

BONSALL - This is an attractive village between Cromford and The Matlocks just of the Youlgreave Road from Cromford long the Via Gellia.

It is a considerable village, in a parish of the same name, about two miles from Cromford and four from Wirksworth, principally seated on a very high hill, where is the church, a neat plain building, in the same patronage as that of Matlock. In 1821 the number of inhabitants in the parish was 1,396.

The 13th century stone built St Jame's Church stands in a prominent position overlooking the village. It has a fine tower surrounded by crowns and gargoyles and is surmounted by a splendid spire. The church has had many additions and extensions throughout the centuries with much of the exterior being rebuilt in 1862. Contains a 17th century funeral helmet in the north aisle.

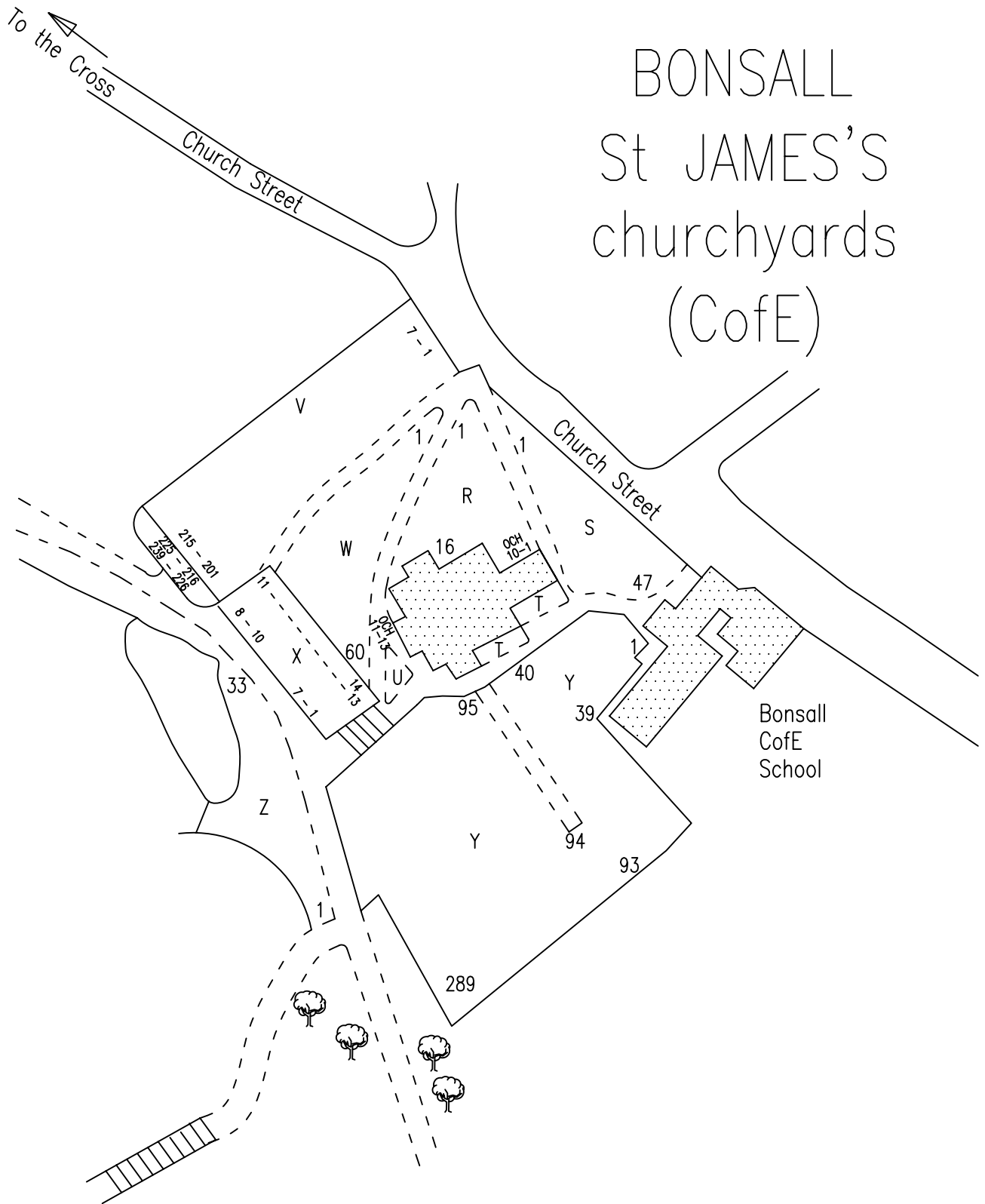
Its Registers date from 1634 and are at the County Record Office. Matlock. It is mentioned in the Domesday Book and is in the midst of former lead mining country.

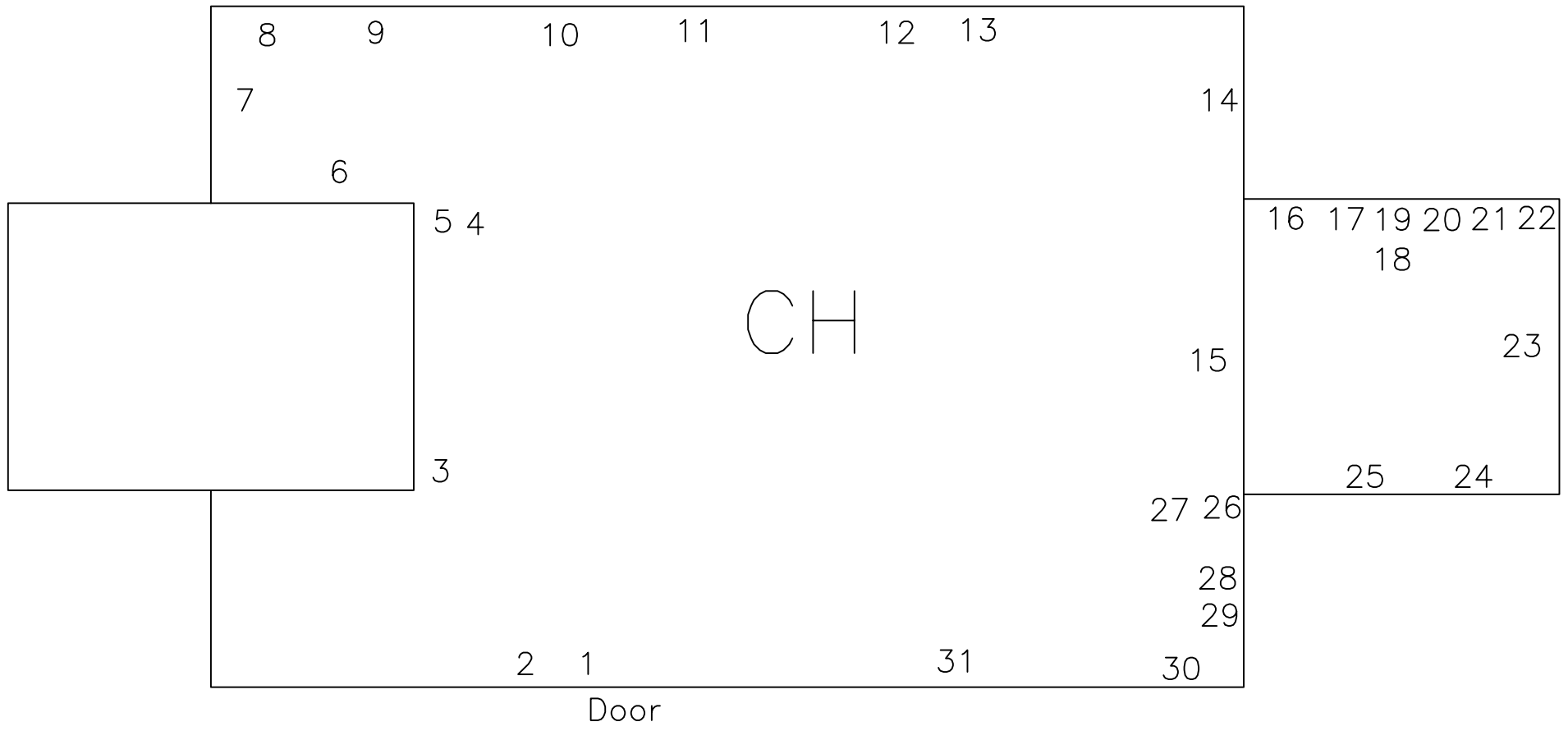
The church is built upon a hill and is the subject of many tales associated with lead mining. There is an old market cross in the Town consisting of a circular shaft on thirteen steps surmounted by a ball.

The village still has well dressing, several wells being dressed on the last day of the Village Wakes festivities, usually on the last Saturday before the first Monday in August and the Village has the remains of an extinct volcano near by.

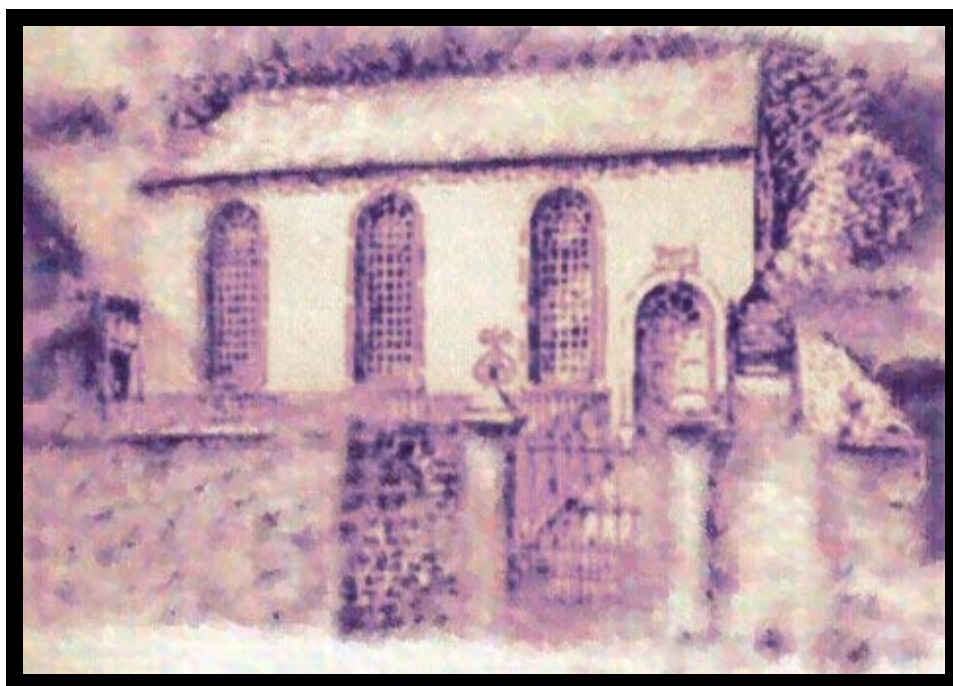
