19/11/9	<p>Finance:</p> <p>a) Payments received: £1100 from Yorkshire & Clydesdale Bank; account Switch incentive.</p> <p>b) The monthly Statement/ Annual Accounts: the statement for period 7 detailing income and expenditure to 01 November 2019 were approved.</p> <p>c) Accounts for payment: payments as below were approved.</p> <p>d) Bank account Switch: the Clerk explained that it had come to light after the switch date on 21st October that RBS bank had only transferred funds in the Parish Council holding account to the new Yorkshire account, but not the linked reserve account where the bulk of funds were held. There was no access to that reserve account without the linked account which had now been closed, so the Council was unable to access funds other than those now in the new Yorkshire account (c. £1400). A complaint had been filed with RBS and upheld, and an account closure had been requested as a matter of urgency to release the funds, but RBS had failed to implement that since 29th October.
