b) Update on repairs to The Cross - The Parish Council have made an application to the Heritage Lottery Fund for £8,000 funding to carry out restoration work on the Cross, the Fountain, the Wells and the Memorials. If successful the work will be carried out in the early part of next year.

c) Vacancies for Councillors – notification had been received that As we are now within six months of the Parish Council elections, scheduled for 5 May 2011, elections will not be held to fill casual vacancies that occur and there is, therefore, no requirement for Parishes to advertise these. Parishes are, however, still at liberty to advertise and fill any vacancy by co-option in accordance with their agreed co-option policy
