PCSO Brooking representative for Derbyshire Constabulary reported

The Police were again monitoring the Moor over the recent Bank holiday. Operation Preston is still continuing. Residents are still being urged to report any incidents on the Moor.

County Councillor Ratcliffe representative for Derbyshire County Council reported

This could be the last meeting for Cllr Ratcliffe as she is standing for re-election in June. The PC thanked Cllr Ratcliffe for all her work in the Parish over the last 4 years. Funding is being sort for transport to the villages to take young people to local youth clubs. The Peak Park rangers and the Police are monitoring the situation on the Moor.

Dist Cllr Purdy reported

The objection to Dunsley Mill is still going ahead, and the Environment Agency are being looked to for more support.

It was noted that there were no signs at Salters Lane – Dist Cllr Purdy will investigate this.

Cllr Howsley reported

The Calor Village of the Year application has been sent off. Cllr Howsley asked for help from Cllrs when the judges come to the village.

Cllr Pountain reported

Cllr Pountain will contact Linda Wells and ask her to do the village planters again this year. The PC agreed to fund this again.

It was decided that this year we will not enter the Bonsall in Bloom competition as we are entering the Calor Village of the Year. Cllr Pountain has confirmed this to Irene Bates, organiser of the competition.

Cllr Lane reported

Cllr Lane attended the School Foundation meeting. The Foundation has funded trips out for the children and the dictionaries for the Year 6 leavers. The school have undertaken a programme of cultural and musical learning. This includes dancing, singing, drumming and making scenery, and concludes in a show at the end of the week.
