We could end up with over £1000 for the Link which would be brilliant.

If you are interested in taking part in this event could you let me know which day you could do and which activity you would prefer, or not prefer? I will get more information about the various roles once I have an idea of numbers. Apparently in previous years, they have struggled a bit because too many of the marshals were youngsters such as scouts, cadets. He is keen to have more older (and therefore more experienced) people helping out this year.
