4 PUBLIC SPEAKING –

DCC Cllr Ratcliffe – Peter Jackson only replied to the request for an update on Moor Lane BOAT as of 20th January:

Councillors received an update on the situation with regard to the Byway Open to All Traffic (BOAT) order on Moor Lane. The situation is that once the routes have been added to the definitive map and granted BOAT status a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) can be made immediately for the route. This is the only way to ban traffic on the route. DCC will take on board objections to the BOAT but they say dealing with those is likely to delay the process and may result in the matter being referred to appeal. In an appeal it is possible that the BOAT would be rejected and then a TRO could not be issued for the road.

Councillors resolved that once the issue of the BOAT and TRO is dealt with they will then look at making appropriate representations to ensure footpaths and bridle paths in the area are open for use The Footpaths Officer from DCC will be invited to a future meeting to discuss the issue. Please talk to one of your Councillors or the Clerk if you want any further information on the process.

The Clerk to include this information in the Mutterings report confirming that the BOAT is to make sure a TRO can be put in place.

Councillors may consider applying for the currently restricted footpath to be re-established.

Invite DCC to a future to PC Meeting to talk about the definitive map

Appeal to attend 9th Feb Area Community Forum.

The Planning Application for affordable housing at Chestnut Farm has been withdrawn. It may be re-submitted pending additional research into the impact on the conservation area and Bonsall Parish Council will circulate information should this be the case
