4 Public Speaking

Walls – considerable damage on Moor Lane by 4x4s have been rebuilt since 2008 damage. 100 metre stretch BOAT Order not confirmed until end of year and there is a further right of appeal before then which could be appeal with the planning inspector.

Can Parish Council contact Peter Jackson at DCC Legal services to express support for rejecting BOAT on Moor Lane.

Cllr Ratcliffe: There are currently consultation running on: the use of children's centres, community transport consultation – dial a ride and Concessionary Buses.

Light at the Corner of The Nook is not working

A member of the public spoke on the proposal to write to DDDC expressing disappointment that the views of Bonsall Parish Council had not been taken into consideration. Firstly he expressed his own disappointment that Cllrs Barry and Harris have failed to disclose interests in Chestnut Farm. He further stated that the Parish Council had made 2 representations and lodged (by a majority vote) no objection to the proposal. Along with the planning response Bonsall Parish Council had listed 3 areas of concern. In response the DDDC Case Officer gave detailed review of the Parish Council comments in the final report and urged Councillors to consider this when deciding on their course of action under item 7 as proposed.
