82/2008/ MARCH- REPORTS BACK FROM REPRESENTATIVES.

County Councillor Ratcliffe representative for Derbyshire County Council & District Councillor Purdy representative for Derbyshire Dales District Council

A report was presented about the Dunsley Mill planning application. Although the application was given approval it was felt that further objections and an appeal will probably be raised. The PC thanked all councillors involved for their hard work and support during this application.

County Councillor Ratcliffe updated the PC on the scramble track that the lease has been passed on to someone else, and is now not in the remit of Mr Rose & Mr Ramsden, further clarification of this is needed. Any noise and nuisance issues should still be reported to the Police.

The PDNPA are sorting out resources to regenerate Blakemere Pit.

PC Spencer representative for Derbyshire Constabulary

PC Spencer has taken over the Masson ward patrols from PC Jones. There is Police presence on the Moor at the weekends and further education days are planned. It has been noted that the signage telling people the track is closed has been ripped down. A challenge is still in place about Dobb Lane. There has been a theft on the Via Gellia and 2 break ins on Clatterway which are being investigated.

Cllr Howsley reported

It was agreed that a thank you should be put in Mutterings to that Cllr Engelbregsten for her work in keeping the Churchyard look nice.

Several people have shown an interest in helping with the Calor Village of the Year competition and Cllr Howsley is organising a meeting at the Kings Head on 23 March at 7.30 for interested parties to attend. It was noted that the only failure at the moment that the village has is for Youth activities on the 11-16 years provision.

Cllr Brazewell reported

Cllr Brazewell has agreed to meet Keith Falconer to discuss the way forward with the Village website, to update it. There are potential links for the Calor Village of the Year through the website, as this is a category of the competition.

Clerks report

It was agreed to promote the Awnings in Mutterings again.

Mrs Smith has decided to resign as Clerk to the Parish Council after 5 ½ years service. An advert for her replacement has been circulated and the closing date is the end of March for applications.
