##### **Cllr Cruttenden reported**

A meeting of the Standards Board has indicated that the new guidelines being brought into effect shortly will only affect the PC with regard to declarations of personal interests. Another meeting is to be held the week after next discuss this further. Cllr Cruttenden asked if anyone will attend the next meeting with him to take over the attendance at the Quarry Liaison meetings due to his pending retirement. Cllr Rowlands indicated she would be interested. The Chair of Rowsley PC has contacted Cllr Cruttenden with regard to an issue with Peak Park planning about plans for nursing home, with conditions being applied to it. "If you have lived in the area for 10 of the last 20 years you can have a place in the home." This seems unfair to many residents who are the boundaries of the Peak Park. Cllr Cruttenden has written to Patrick McLoughlin MP about this.

##### **Cllr Headon reported**

During the recent spell of bad weather some subsidence in the cemetery has taken place. This is being dealt with.

##### **Cllr Rowlands reported**

PC Wright visited the Moor on Sunday and went to see bikers that where there. He checked the bikes that should only be used as off road vehicles, and made the bikers aware that there would be a continuing Police presence monitoring the biker's activities. No gates were blocked and the complaint that was received about the biker with the Rottweiler in his vehicle was not there. PC Wright will now liase with Kate Taylor regarding any future problems. During the recent cutting of the hedges some of the footpath signs have been damaged. Cllr Rowlands will follow up getting these replaced and also enquire about getting some of the stiles repaired as they are in a dangerous state of repair, particularly the one near the Allotments.

Mr & Mrs Millward attended the meeting and updated the PC on the latest footpath news. Mr Millward has had on going issues with Phil Berry since April 2006 and many of these issues have not been followed up. After Mr Millward complained he has now been contacted by Phil Berry and Mr Millward read out his response. It was agreed that Mr Millward forward his response to the Clerk who will circulate it to the PC. Volunteers have cleared Dobb Lane, and further work is to be done. A fall tree has now been removed. There is still a drainage problem and the owners of land are being contacted about this. County Cllr Ratcliffe has assured Mr Millward that the work is being done. The PC thanked Mr & Mrs Millward for the update.

Mr & Mrs Millward left the meeting.

##### **Cllr Pountain reported**

Cllr Pountain met with County Cllr Ratcliffe about the overhanging trees on the Via Gellia, and she agreed it was a mess and needed to be dealt with. County Cllr Ratcliffe was following this up.

Isabel Bellamy from Derbyshire Rural group has asked if the PC would like to do another survey on the parish needs, as she feels the last one was not a true reflection of the village.
