#### **Cllr Falconer reported**

The village websites main name Bonsall.org is due for renewal, and Cllr Falconer has purchased this for the village through his sons company previously. Cllr Falconer asked the PC if they wished to continue with this arrangement for the web hosting fee. The PC agreed to continue using this service at a cost price. The amount this year will probably be around £100.

#### **Cllr Cartwright reported**

The memorial seat dedicated to Steph Griffiths has been vandalised. The seat has now been repaired. The Police are to be contacted and Bonsall's no vandalism record has been broken this year. A report about this incident is to appear in the next Mutterings.

Cllr Cartwright attended the Parish councils evening given by Derbyshire Constabulary. A variety of topics were discussed, funding, community safety and what is the role of the new "special constables" going to be.

The local speed limits on A & B roads are to be reassessed. Cllr Cartwright expressed the PC's view about the speed on the Via Gellia and through the village to Neil Hickman DCC. Local fine tuning is to be looked at for individual villages needs.

Under the new Fire Assessments Risks, any establishment i.e., village halls that provide accommodation for meetings and functions, should have a fire assessment risk plan and any groups using this accommodation are responsible for having their own fire assessment risk.

The PC meeting are responsible to do fire risk for themselves. This will be followed up. Information received from DALC about the Breathing Spaces project run by the Big Lottery is to be pursued, as there could be [potential funding for some village projects. (Framework Knitters). An application pack will be obtained from the big lottery website.

The trees on Dobb and Pounder Lane are to be cleared now the paths have been cleared.

Balleye Quarry is working within its approval limits.

Tarmac to take over the running of Middleton Mine, and there is a possibility that mining and processing work will recommence. .

#### **Cllr Pountain reported**

From the Pig of Lead going towards ball eye quarry there are trees hanging over road. The landowner is responsible for their maintenance. County Cllr Ratcliffe is too contacted about this. The leaves on Clatterway need removing DDDC are to be contacted.

Cllr Pountain recently attended the New Councillors training day and gained a Certificate of Attendance.

### **Cllr Rowlands reported**

After notifying County Cllr Ratcliffe about the fly tipping of the lorry tyres, DCC came and removed half of the tyres the next day. There have been more reports of fly tipping at Bottom Lees Farm and Blakemere. PC Wright is to be notified of current events. The problem seems to be getting worse and Cllr Rowlands is getting complaints every week. County Cllr Ratcliffe is to be contacted again and thanks to be passed on for the work recently done.

### **Cllr Headon reported**

A tree is still blocking footpath at Dunesley Wood just passed Cllr Headon's house. This will be follow up with DCC.

Cllr Cartwright has passed some low energy light bulbs on to some older people in the village. The remaining bulbs are to be passed on to Peter Fox and other contacts for distribution.
