207/2005/ APRIL - REPORTS BACK FROM REPRESENTATIVES.

Dist Cllr March reported that a number of residence have requested a compostable wheeled bin, but are yet to receive them. Many have come from resident still on sack collections and so this is being pursued further.

Cllr Falconer reported that the Village hall committee are looking into the possibility of having some members trained to hold the new licensing certificate, which is required, to be able to hold events at the hall. A one-day course costs around £150.

A tender is going to be put into Mutterings to see if anyone is interested in painting the Village Hall. The purchase of a LINK line for the deaf will take place shortly.

Cllr Headon has written to Derbyshire county council conveying our concerns about the accidents on the Via Gellia road. He awaits a reply.

Cllr Headon and Cllr Lynch have erected the Uppertown notice board. The proposed site for the Slaley board has been moved slightly up the road, as the original owner of the house, of which the board would be closest to, has requested that it not be placed there. Another resident has made an informal remark to Cllr Headon about the new site of the board, but at present the Parish Council has received no official complaint.

It was agreed to try to print the minutes smaller and on fewer sheets of paper to display in the boards.

208/2005/ APRIL – FRIENDS OF BONSALL FRAMEWORK KNITTERS.

Cllr Falconer reported that a letter has been written to Mrs Phipps, the owner of the property, informing her of the proposed plans. A donation from the carnival committee of £145 towards the project has been received.

209/2005/ APRIL – ALLOTMENTS AND FOOTBALL PITCH.

The planning application for the Allotments has been refused by Derbyshire Dales District Council. After taking further advice, it has been discovered that planning permission was not necessary for this project, and a meeting will be arranged between several councillors, and DDDC planners and their solicitors.

Quotes are being sought for the car parking materials.

A letter to the potential families interested will be sent out after clarification of the planning issue.

Cromford Parish Council has a demand for Allotments, if we have a shortfall of people still interested from the village.

210/2005/ APRIL –PARISH MEETING.
